


# Getting around in Prague

Prague has a very good public transportation system consisting of three subway (metro) lines (named A, B, C), several tram lines (numbered 1-26, plus two special lines, 41 and 42), and bus lines (numbered 101-250, plus special line 58). You will receive a public transportation ticket valid for the duration of the conference upon registration.




The conference venue is located centrally in Prague, close to the Old Town Square, just next to the Vltava river.






Conference dinner will be served in the National House of Vinohrady. It is 3 subway stations away from the conference venue

## From Vaclav Havel airport to the conference venue

#### Taxi

At Terminal 1 and 2 Arrival halls, the sales counters of these taxi service providers are located: FIX TAXI (+420 722 555 525) and Taxi Praha ( +420 220 414 414). Or you can call AAA Taxi Prague (+420 222 333 222). The price will be appr. 600 – 800 CZK (25-35 EUR), it should take 30-45 min to the conference venue (there may be some traffic jams). We strongly recommend using apps like Uber or Bolt because it is cheaper than a regular taxi. The prices are mostly around 500 CZK depending on the time of arrival. You can also order Prague Airport Transfer <a href="https://booking.prague-airport-transfers.co.uk/en">https://booking.prague-airport-transfers.co.uk/en</a>. The prices are 450 – 970 CZK (19 – 41 EUR) depending on the car of your preference. This service is very reliable and connected to your flight, so you do not need to worry about delays. The driver will wait for you in the arrival hall. He will hold a sign with your name on it.

### **Public transport**

The connection between Václav Havel Airport Prague and Prague city center is provided by public transport bus lines, which operate at regular few-minute intervals. Bus stops are located directly in front of terminals. Please, take bus no. 119 and change to the subway Line A at station Nádraží Veleslavín (terminal station of the bus). Take the subway to the station Staroměstská, direction Depo Hostivař. The station Staroměstská is 5-10 minutes walk from the Faculty of Law. Duration: 30 minutes, intervals 5 – 20 minutes; from 4 am to 11 pm. Tickets for 90 min in public transport vehicles (busses, metro, and trams) cost 40 CZK. There are ticket vending machines at the airport, bus stops, and subway stations. Many of them accept credit cards, but there are also old ones that accept coins only. You will receive a public transportation ticket valid for the duration of the conference upon registration, so get only a single ride ticket.

NOTE: Before the first ride a ticket must be validated in a stamp machine on a bus / tram / at the entrance to the subway station.

# From the main railway station to the conference venue

### Taxi

There is a taxi terminal in front of the railway station building. Follow "TAXI" signs. You can also call AAA Taxi Prague (+420 222 333 222), FIX TAXI (+420 722 555 525) or Taxi Praha (+420 220 414 414). The price will be appr. 150 – 300 CZK (6-12 EUR), depending on the time. It should take about 10-20 min to get to the conference venue (there may be some traffic jams). We strongly recommend using apps like Uber or Bolt because it is cheaper than a regular taxi. The prices are mostly around 150 CZK depending on the time of arrival.

### **Public transport**

Take subway line C directly from the Main Railway Station (Hlavní nádraží) to the station Muzeum, follow the green signs to change to subway line A. Take line A to the station Staroměstská, direction Nemocnice Motol. The station Staroměstská is 5-10 minutes of walk from the Faculty of Law.

<u>Duration</u>: 20 minutes, intervals 5 – 15 minutes; from 4 am to 11 pm.

<u>Tickets</u> for 30 min in public transport vehicles (busses, metro, and trams) cost 30 CZK (40 CZK for 90 minutes). There are ticket vending machines in the railway station hall, at all subway stations and in trams. Many of them accept credit cards, but there are also old ones that accept coins only. You will receive a public transportation ticket valid for the duration of the conference upon registration, so get only a single ride ticket.

NOTE: Before the first ride a ticket must be validated in a stamp machine on a bus / tram / at the entrance to the subway station.

### From the conference venue to conference dinner

Conference dinner will be served in the National House of Vinohrady (Národní dům na Vinohradech). Address: Náměstí Míru 9, Prague 2.

The National House building is located in the district of Vinohrady, just 3 subway stations away from the conference venue. Enter subway line A at Staroměstská station, direction Depo Hostivař. Continue three stops to the Náměstí míru station. Leave the station using the E1 exit, and you will see the National House just in front of you.

The public transportation ticket received upon registration can be used for this trip.
